### Medical Manpower Shortages Kathleen Haley, Executive Director Oregon Medical Board, Portland

The mission of the Oregon Medical Board is to protect the health, safety, and well being of Oregon citizens by regulating the practice of medicine in a manner that promotes quality care.

In addition to its licensing functions, the Board conducts investigations, imposes disciplinary action, and supports rehabilitation, education, and research to further its legislative mandate to protect the citizens of Oregon. The Oregon Medical Board is also responsible for the scope of practice of First Responders and EMTs. The Board presently licenses Medical Doctors (MD), Doctors of Osteopathic Medicine (DO), Podiatric Physicians (DPM), Physician Assistants (PA), and Acupuncturists (LAc).

In addition to serving as Executive Director of the Oregon Medical Board, Ms. Haley is a Clinical Associate Professor at Oregon Health and Science University. She is the Editor of *The Oregon Death with Dignity Act: A Guidebook for Health Care Providers*, 1998 and the author of "Mothers Behind Bars: A Look at the Parental Rights of Incarcerated Women," Vol. 4, No. 1, *New England Journal on Prison Law*.

A frequent lecturer and moderator, Ms. Haley graduated from the State University of New York and earned her law degree at the New England School of Law in Boston, Massachusetts.

Ms. Haley formerly served as Assistant Attorney General in the New York State Department of Law, as Trial Counsel for Bennett and Hartman of Portland, Oregon and as Executive Director of the Oregon Psychiatric Security Review Board.
