Oregon Rotary Model United Nations **by the Numbers**

- \$10,500 = estimated cost for 9 teams
 - \$11,065 = actual cost for 9 teams
 - \$1,230 = actual cost per team (two students and one advisor)
 - \$410 = cost per person (including advisors)
- \$1,161 = value of donated supplies and materials (Liz Ness, Jerry Harris, Jane Scheidecker)
 - \$420 = value of donated photography/videography services (Steve Ness, Jeff Stimler, Jane Scheidecker, Ravitej Khalsa)

- Student delegate recruitment = November 2018 – January 2019
 - Delegate Selection = January 2019
 - Team Research = January – March 2019
 - MUN General Assembly duration = two days (Sat. and Sun., April 6-7, 2019)
 - Venue = Valley River Inn, Eugene, Oregon
- Targeted Students = AVID
 - Final Student Makeup = Mix of AP and AVID
 - Research Tasks = Research your country's political, social, economic and cultural history, prepare one 5-minute speech of country's position on draft Resolution, prepare an amendment to the Resolution, prepare to defend your positions

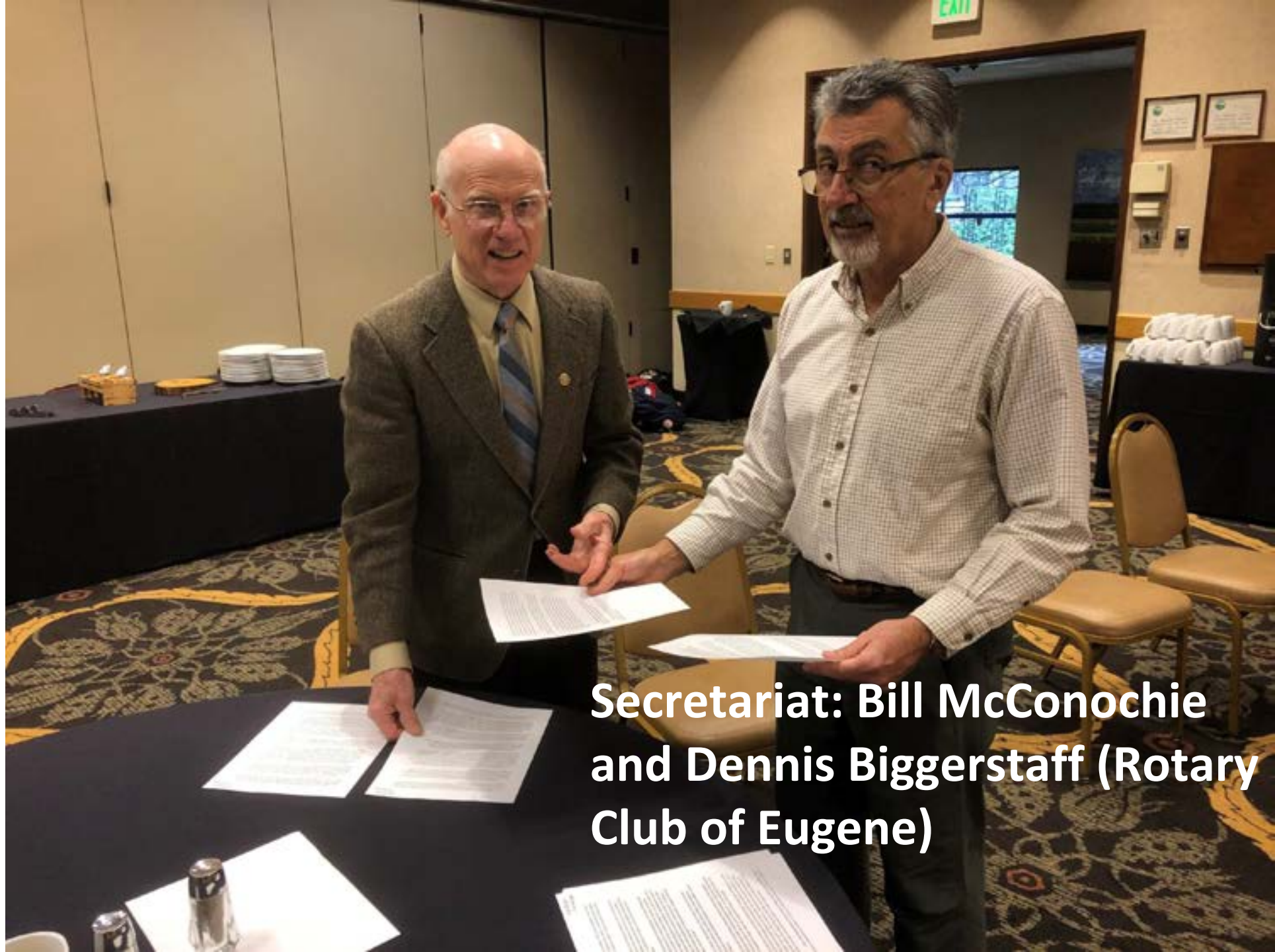
